If giving online, please select "Refugee Fund" from the dropdown of options.



Prayer Update from Cory & Masami Giesbrecht (Multiply)

To the end of myself..

Some people are getting to the end of their rope during this pandemic period.

Recently a friend of mine reached the end of his resources since he lost his job during the Corona shutdown. Although he had promised himself that he would never ask a Christian for money, he had to ask me to lend him some money to pay his rent. The night before we met he had a dream which he believes was from God. A typewriter was pounding out a message saying: "It's okay. You can break this promise now. Later I will give you a chance to help someone else and the shame will be erased. There is something else I want you to know: If a time comes when there is no-one to help you I will help you myself"

Kouji told me about his dream while we were walking the streets at night - having no place to sit down because of the shutdown. Kouji has a great testimony of going (somewhat unwillingly) to a gospel music concert three years ago and being surprised there by an experience of the healing presence of Jesus. Although he has attended church off-and-on since then he has never fully surrendered his life and his will to Jesus. In a dark and empty park he decided to pray to receive Jesus as his savior and Lord. It seems that God was using the desperation of his situation to bring him to the end of himself.

Let's pray that Kouji will be able to take more steps of obedience like baptism and joining a faith-family.

God is also bringing me to the end of myself as I disciple Kouji and other men. So many times I do not know what to say or do and am forced to go to God in prayer.

Let's keep an eye open to what God is up to around us in this season. Are there people around you that Jesus may be drawing to himself through the COVID-19 situation?
