Missionary Update—Dave & Louise Sinclair (Multiply)

Why Doing Business AND Starting New Churches is a WIN-WIN This what we have accomplished **TOGETHER doing Business As Mission in 2020**...

- 1. Hundreds of farmers who had no market for their crops, have been trained to grow specialty coffee.
- 2. Over 70 farms, hundreds of farmers, local people, pastors and evangelists have received a fair wage for their coffee beans. (Over 3x the amount they received in the past.)
- 3. Many of our church planters and pastors have become "early adopters" and have started planting 1-5 acres of coffee. With the expectancy that the Arabica coffee trees will mature in 3-5 years, our pastors have a goal to become self-sustaining, enabling them to make disciples and plant churches, while providing for their family's education and healthcare. This vision "raises the ceiling" for us. Soon foreign funds will no longer limit the number of churches that can be planted in Myanmar.
- 4. Hundred's of local farmers from 7 villages have heard the Gospel for the first time. Recently, over 30 coffee farmers and family members have been baptized!
- 5. This year, **thanks to our great team of volunteers in Canada**, over **13,000 DOLLARS** in profit was made from sales! These monies will be donated back to our company's charitable foundation in Myanmar to be used to build schools, clinics and train ethical leaders. If that's not a win-win, I don't know what is!
