
## **Praise Report**

CMU is rooted in both Mennonite Brethren and Mennonite Church denominations. As we move past the era of MB Seminary affiliation with CMU, the University is committed to sustaining a strong MB voice within its MDiv and MA (Theological Studies and Christian Ministry) degrees, and indeed also within all of its graduate and undergraduate degree programs, Outtatown, and the CMU Centre for Faith and Life. CMU is hopeful that the funding for Pierre Gilbert and Andrew Dyck will continue past May 2021 in full-time roles; this will be possible if the congregations of MBCM affirm and support that calling. CMU also is grateful for the health of its longstanding relationship with MBCM, and for the quality of leadership MBCM is demonstrating regarding the future of ministry training and Biblical and Theological education in the MB tradition.
