Multiply Missions Update — Sandra & Isra Chavez Plett

This pandemic provides so much opportunity for us to wait and see what God is going to do, and how He is going to do it. I am reminded of how He longs to do new things in and through us. But often we aren't patient enough or attentive enough to really look for it. In June we were praying and earnestly seeking what God wanted to do with our international students, as the end date of our program was approaching. When we received word that our Colombian students were accepted on humanitarian flights we quickly did debrief, celebrated a graduation and got them on those flights within a few days. God provided a pathway! It felt a bit abrupt to end that way, but we were thankful that most of our students could return home. Since we ended so quickly, we are continuing to do some debrief through zoom calls. Please continue to pray for our student Sairoze from Mozambique as he still isn't able to return home. God has laid so many dreams on his heart. and he is anxious to return and put them into action. We are praying that God makes a way for him.

As a team we took some significant time to retreat together once our program ended. It was a special time to debrief and evaluate the six months we've spent working together as a new team. But also to dream, vision and listen to God together for the future. God is giving us new ideas and it's so exciting! As a former team of 4 it feels good to look back and see God's faithfulness in laying a firm foundation in the work He has called us to in Mexico. But now we are on the brink of something new...new rivers that He will use our team of 9 to travel down, build upon and explore as He calls us to expand our vision and go deeper.

Continue to pray for our team as we build trust and relationship. God is up to something great here, but we also recognize the need to continually seek unity in our differences. Pray that we would be a team that communicates well and always seeks after God's vision together.

For the next 2 weeks you can find us right here, in quarantine in my dad's house in Blumenort, Manitoba. He graciously gave up his space and went to stay with my brother and sister-in-law so we could enjoy his bit of paradise. People have been so generous with bringing us food and special treats, and being able to get out into the vard makes these 14 days so much more bearable.

After we are done quarantine we will begin 3 months on MINA in Canada. This is a time for us to visit our supporting churches. connect with individuals, share about what God is doing in Mexico. and raise some additional support. I am so excited for Isra to meet all of you, and for you to meet him.


