

#### Celebrating Advent with RETO Pinar

We've been back in Mexico for just over a month and have jumped back into our ministry activities. Because of the situation with Covid in Mexico, we continue to meet as a church online. Typically Advent is a religious custom of the Catholic Church in Mexico and is seldom celebrated as such in the Evangelical Church here. Personally I find such beauty in this season of waiting in anticipation, and love how practicing Advent helps me to slow down and reflect on different themes. So this year Isra and I decided to focus our four weekend services before Christmas on themes of hope, peace, faith and joy.

Because we haven't met in person since March, and we haven't had face-to-face connection with a number of our members since then, we decided to put together an Advent gift-bag and hand-deliver them to our church families. The idea is that each weekend during our online service we will open a gift together, and light an advent candle as an act of unity and focussing together on the season. We were so impacted at the joy on people's faces as they received these small gifts and a personal visit. A reminder of how we all need personal connection and care!
