MISSION UPDATE - Randy Friesen (Multiply)

Our workers in Southeast Asia have led hundreds to Christ in recent weeks and we want to thank you for participating through your prayers and gifts! Here's one story from that region that Jeremy and Adrienne Penner shared from the Burmese work. It's about a woman of faith named Pastor Janu, who was abandoned by her husband several years ago and fled her home in Myanmar to Thailand desperately looking for work with her four small children in tow. In Thailand, she met Jesus and her life was transformed. Today, she's living a life of sacrifice and sharing the Gospel with her people.

This is the fruit of sacrificial living—a harvest for eternity—because Pastor Janu and her family have chosen to live like eternity matters more than earthly comforts. Her sacrifice matters—it matters to all of her disciples and our team of church planters that are watching her live for Christ. It spurs them on and gives them faith that God will provide for them too. But more than that, Pastor Janu's sacrifice matters to the 395 people in her city who just heard about the saving love of Jesus Christ for the first time and put their faith in him

I'm reminded of the sacrifice of the widow's mite (Mark 12:41-44) that Jesus commended. As we live on mission in 2021, what is the Lord asking us to sacrifice? Join us this year in "Listening to the Word" each day and praying daily for our global workers.

We have been so encouraged by the financial support and prayers of our churches over this past season!
