
Annual Financial Reports

MISSION UPDATE - Victor Wiens (ICOMB)

Dear friends,

Soon we will reach the one-year mark of this pandemic (the World Health Organization declared a pandemic in March 2020). This is not a joyful anniversary - we grieve the loss of family, friends, ministries, and opportunities. Yes, as confirmed below in the prayer requests from our global family, "we suffer with those who suffer."

I am sure you have been asked, and maybe have asked yourself, "What is God saying?" Seven times in Revelation, we read "Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches." Have we been listening? Early in the pandemic, I started a list on my phone notepad called "COVID-19 + God's messages." Here is what I have heard so far over these 12 months:

- 1 A call to God's people to repent (II Chronicles 7:14).
- 2 Many lives will be saved (Genesis 50:20).
- 3 Look to God, not to human resources and idols.
- 4 To the Church: you are ... salt ... light ... a city on a hill (Matthew 5:13-14).
- Pestilence, calamities, and plagues in Scripture can come from God (Revelation 15). When they do, they are meant to lead God's people and others to repentance.
- This is a test for the Church to live out what we sing and preach ... will we respond as the world does? Will we be selfish and isolated? Will we be afraid to die?
- 7 Fear God!
- 8 This is a season of Jubilee to restore the soil of our hearts unto greater fruitfulness.
- 9 Confident rest in the midst of the storm (remember Jesus in the boat).
- 10 Return to your first love: love God, love family, love neighbors.
- 11 A time to learn some new patterns for discipleship and ministry.
- 12 Remember who controls times and seasons. Remember how vulnerable we humans are!

What have you heard? Let us "spur each other on to love and good deeds," and encourage each other with the words God is giving to us in this time of trial. You are in our thoughts and prayers.
