
# WHATS HAPPENING

# MISSION UPDATE - Dave & Louise (Multiply)

You've probably already heard...

February 1, 2021. It was supposed to be the first day of the newly elected Parliament. But instead, the military overthrew the democratically elected government in Myanmar.

The deep pain and sorrow this caused 54 million people can hardly be expressed. After surviving 50 years of brutal military rule, injustice, starvation and isolation from the world, the Myanmar people defiantly started banging pots and pans at 8pm every night. Suddenly, their cry for justice was louder than their fear of the military!

No Myanmar person will ever forget the blood that flowed in the streets when over 10,000 people lost their lives in the last uprising against the military in 1988. Would people dare to challenge the corrupt and ruthless military again? Would they dare to challenge General Min Aung Hlaing, the one responsible for the Coup? YES THEY WOULD!

Right now, as you read this, teachers, doctors, nurses, engineers, farmers, miners, young and old, from every city and state in Myanmar, have been on the streets every day, gathering in such mass numbers that no one can count. People are shouting, "We will not pass this evil dictatorship on to another generation!"

Meanwhile, far away in the western mountains of Myanmar, the harvest stops for no one. Especially if you want to eat. Desperate farmers, needing to feed their families, are working around the clock to dry and hull 40 tons of Arabica coffee cherries. With an abundant harvest, Isaiah is predicting he will have 16 tons of coffee this year. That's 6X more coffee than we exported last year! But with such political upheaval, will that even be possible?

The discipleship training centre/coffee storage/sleeping area; the place Isaiah calls "3 in 1" is almost finished! During the day, our new Bible school interns work in factories all over Thailand and on the coffee mountain in Myanmar. But during the evening, they get online, open their Bibles and prepare to be good teachers of the Word of God!

Would you pray with us for peace and for God's Kingdom to come to Myanmar?
