MISSION UPDATE - Matt Peters (Equip Canada)

It's exciting when the Lord speaks. On a particular wilderness trip a number of years ago, I was sitting on a high cliff with a group of teenage boys. We were on a spring hike deep into the Mantario wilderness area. A theme developed as we trekked through the scarred landscape of a recent forest fire. Summer was a few days away and these boys were unsure of their plans. At their age, it was a big deal of what to make of their open summer schedule. I remember being inspired to sit silently with them and listen to what the Lord had to say. We sat quietly in God's presence and let Him do the talking. We had no where to be and nothing to distract us. I remember vividly how God had a Word for each of those boys. It was humbling to experience that with them and encouraging to see them walk forward with confidence and trust. The were on a hiking adventure with us, but a bigger adventure with God.

This past January, I was feeling lost with many unknowns to navigate through during this pandemic. Attempting to plan a way forward for this project was seeming impossible to do. One day I felt a familiar inspiration to listen to what the Lord had to say about it. I made a deliberate effort to step back and commit a few days to listen. That's when the Lord spoke.

I heard the Lord say, "Wait". He followed up with scripture from Isaiah 40:31 which says, "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint." Wow! This was a wake up call for me. The Lord was asking us to actively and eagerly anticipate what He is going to do. This Word came at the right time and I had a strong sense of "hang on, we're about to go on an adventure with the Lord!"
