All this being said, we are very excited about meeting in person and we are thankful for this opportunity to do it in a safe manner. If you have any questions please contact one of the pastors.


## WHATS HAPPENING

# MISSION UPDATE - Jen Schmidt (Multiply)

#### Jen's Journey - Tranistions

As a Matthew Team, we regularly work at the property, gardening, cleaning and learning to do many new tasks in order to care for the property. I was struck a few weeks ago by a task we were doing. We had dug out a row of cypress trees the week before that had been planted about 7 years ago. In their prime, they were beautiful and flourishing and lush. They were a beautiful hedge around our property. But it was time for them to be uprooted and something new put into their place. As we planted the new trees, this new team of 7 people, it felt symbolic for me. These trees were baby trees, ready to be planted. They had already begun to grow and take shape and form, but they are delicate and need lots of attention and care. We prepared the soil for these trees, in order to give them the best possible chance at thriving and surviving. The roots of these trees need to grow down deep in order to survive. I feel like this is us as a team. I'm not saying that us as leaders are necessarily young or inexperienced, but rather us as a team are young and will grow. We are just a week away from saying farewell to Trever and Joan. They have done much for us as a team in order to prepare us, nurture and guide us and have been allowing us now to function as the 7 of us, with them just looking on, encouraging us, coaching us and preparing to leave and begin a new season in retirement. As a new team, there is lots of care and attention to be given as we grow and learn how to be team together. I believe that if we want to see growth happen for us as a team (just as I'm hoping for growth for these trees), it means our roots being firmed established and growing deep. As I walk by these trees on a regular basis, it's God's reminder to me to pray for us as a new team. I'm reminded of some favorite verses from Colossians.

"Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him." (Colossians 2:7a)
