Dear Friends,

Confucius, a 6th century BC Chinese philosopher, probably sat in front of a mountain, reflecting on how to move it. He came to the conclusion, "the man who moves a mountain begins by carrying away small stones." We tend to forget that to move a big obstacle, or build something great, or reach a far goal, we start with little steps. When we look at a great project or movement, we tend to forget it started with little steps.

In the kingdom of God, we also tend to forget the little steps at the beginning and while it's being built. Even if we don't value them, God does. "God is great not just because nothing is too big. God is great because nothing is too small...We want to do amazing things for God, but that isn't our Job. Our Job is to consecrate ourselves to God, then God does amazing things for us." (Mark Patterson) "God says to Israel: "Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin..." (Zechariah 4:9-10 NLT).

I hope you are encouraged by looking at the small or big things God is doing in your personal life, your family, your church, your
