



#### **Donwood Manor - Board Vacancy**



# MISSION UPDATE - Randy Friesen (Vision for Mission)

Transitions in leadership are one of the ways God renews organizations and keeps us healthy. After seventeen years as General Director of Multiply, and over 30 years of mission work with our MB conference, I am transitioning out of Multiply on April 15 to make way for new leadership. It has been an incredible privilege to serve our global MB family in mission these many years. My first call to youth ministry came through Chuck Buller and Waterloo MB (Ontario) in 1986. After experiencing the discipleship impact of training young leaders in missional contexts, I was asked by James Nikkel to lead the ongoing short-term mission training program which came to be known as Youth Mission International. Our focus was "mobilizing and discipling a generation of end-time harvesters." That ministry grew to over 1000 participants and we merged with MB Mission (MBMS International at the time), bringing together short-term and long-term mission participants and strategies. When I was asked to give overall leadership to MB Mission in 2004, I accepted the role with an awareness of our history in church planting and our commitment to serve the International Community of MBs (ICOMB). As we grew in scope and partnerships, we focused on core values like dependency on Jesus, risk-taking obedience and transforming community. We responded to the opportunities the Lord placed before us and we expanded our ministry in North Africa, Southeast Asia and among Turkic peoples.

I love our MB family. I believe that our DNA of clear evangelical convictions and our understanding of the Gospel of reconciliation are good news in this generation. In future 'Vision for Mission' emails, you will hear other voices within Multiply sharing stories of God at work around the world and inviting you to participate in the mission of Jesus. The Lord of the harvest continues to have assignments for all of us and I look forward to what the Lord has in store as we live on mission together.
