We are in need of a number of building supervisors for church events and rentals. If you would be willing and able to serve the church in this way please contact the office.

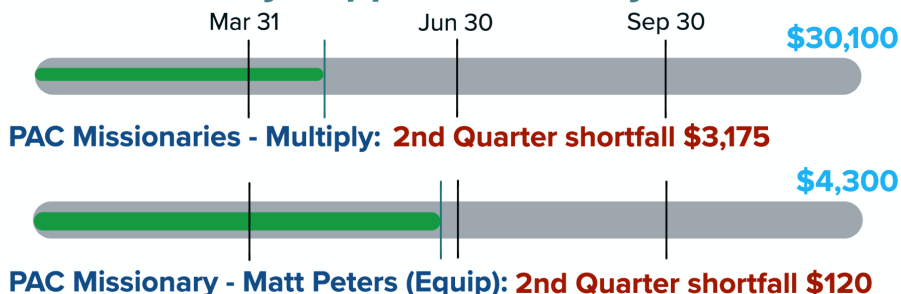
Alpha for Jr. High:
