MISSION UPDATE - Rudi Plett (ICOMB)

Paul has a sensitive message to give to the Israelites in Rome (Rom 9:6). Before expressing it, he communicates how much he loves them, and he assures them that he sees God's love and work among them (Rom 9:1-5).

He loves them very much: "... I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh." (Rom 9:2-3) But he knows that this could be seen as flattery, as an untrue story to gain their openness. So, he starts with: "I am speaking the truth in Christ—I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit." (Room 9:1)

He is demonstrating how he self examined to make sure he was speaking the truth. Knowing he is in Christ, who knows each thought, he consulted his conscience, letting the Holy Spirit confirm it. He was not afraid to see what was in his heart and expose it to the Holy Spirit. I'm sure he saw thoughts and feelings that God wanted to change, heal, or restore. But this exposure also gave him the assurance that his sacrificial love was real and true.

How good would it be, if before we communicate something sensitive, we examine ourselves to know whether our sacrificial love is real and true. If we pause to acknowledge the good work God has been doing among those we are communicating with. If we then share the challenging message that comes from God and shows a path towards his grace, love, and redemption.

Let's not be afraid to expose our heart in front of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit wants to transform us to the likeness of Christ. God wants to implant his love, show us what he is doing, and give us a message to share.
