

Dear friends,


In my devotional time, I read: "Nothing can injure us emotionally unless it causes us to respond with the wrong attitude. Disappointing circumstances will pass, but one's reaction to them is a moral and spiritual choice that can influence our life forever." (Floyd McClung Jr., "Father Heart of God"). I began to reflect on my life and the lives I'm related to. Isn't it true that many times our reaction to a disappointment caused consequences far beyond the impact of the disappointment? Families, partnerships, and churches broke and could not be restored anymore. How many times a leader or leadership reacted in such a way that hundreds or thousands of people were affected. Sometimes even to a loss of life.

We are a global family with thousands of leaders in different roles. Can we help each other to react in a way that permits healing, growing, and deepens the relationship, rather than the opposite? Disappointing circumstances are moments where we need brothers and sisters to help us make the right moral and spiritual choices.

I hope and pray that ICOMB grows as a community and these kinds of relationships are promoted. At the end of June (23-25) we will have our annual Summit.
