## MISSION UPDATE - Rudi Plett (ICOMB)

Dear Friends,

I hope you find reasons to be thankful even amidst challenges. May this Prayer Update not only inform you but also encourage you in your journey.

Moses was a great leader. But he had to make tough decisions, made mistakes, was sometimes impulsive, and not always wise. But then comes a description of him that surprised me strongly the first time I read it: "Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth." (Num 12:3). Beyond the good or bad decisions he had taken, there was something deeper to who he was that carried his leadership: his relationship with God was definitely a centerpiece in his heart.

Many of us are leaders who make good and bad decisions. But what carries our leadership? The following words from McClung made me reflect. I hope they will also encourage you to reflect. "Leadership is not a position of power, but a collection of practices and principles that flow out of who a person is. In their hearts, people don't follow positions—they follow people. Leadership is a relational process of influencing others toward a common purpose." (McClung, Floyd. Leading Like Jesus: 40 Leadership Lessons From the Upside-Down Kingdom)

I hope you can experience, as a leader, this transformation in your life, so that one day others recognize in you what is said about Moses. May it be so! United in Christ,
