# MISSION UPDATE - Jen Schmidt (Multiply)

It had been almost a year since running our Hadime program because of COVID19. It was a year of rental groups at MTC (when COVID permitted), team transitions, new roles and discipleship outside of Hadime. What a joy it's been for me to see us as a team begin a new cycle of Hadime. God has sent us 6 young adults, 2 from Colombia and 4 from different parts of Mexico. These weeks have been filled with sharing testimonies, teachings on spiritual disciplines and growing together as a new community. It's been such a privilege to be apart of these weeks and to see what God has been doing prior to their arrival to MTC and what God has began to stir in their hearts in these last few weeks. Pray for God's transformational work and healing in the lives of these young people. I met Edson (the young man in this photo) in a church service a month before Hadime. I appreciated his openness and sincerity as he shared with me how he had come to know the Lord. I sensed a deep hunger in him to know God in a deeper and more personal way. Edson told me that he was planning on participating in a weekend event (coming up soon!) of inner healing. I asked him what held him back from participating in the 6 month program that we were preparing for. I sensed his interest and celebrated his courageous "Yes" a few days before our program was about to begin. Our team had been so intentional in praying for all those that were on the fringes of the decision to participate or not and we are thankful for each one of these young adults that God has sent us to invest in during this season.

**From the Refugee Committee:** In December 2019, a young Afghan woman and her two children arrived in Winnipeg. She had been sponsored as a refugee by this church. As soon as she arrived, we applied for her husband to be able to come to Canada to join her.

After this application had sat in an in-tray in Ottawa for a year and a half, the government suddenly decided to take action, and yesterday we were informed that the husband will arrive in Winnipeg very soon - date unspecified, but probably some time in August. In the present season, we have to arrange quarantine accommodation for him.

So does anybody have a self-contained basement, apartment or cottage that they could make available for two weeks some time in August? It has to be self-contained, because the refugee isn't allowed to mingle with anyone he didn't travel with. If you can do this, you will have bestowed an enormous blessing on this refugee, and also saved PAC the enormous expense of lodging him in a quarantine hotel.
