Pastor Isaiah is feeling much better! He is still weak but his oxygen levels are normal. Pastor Isaiah's wife, Amon is still sick with covid. Please continue to remember her in your prayers.

Pastor Moe Aung is still in the hospital receiving oxygen. He says, "Thank you for all your prayers! I am feeling much better." The blessing in this hardship is that if Pastor Moe Aung had not contracted covid, he never would have gone to a hospital for treatment. Surprisingly, he learned that he also has diabetes! He finally understands why he has felt exhausted for such a long time. Please pray that he can learn how to take better care of himself. <u>New Problems - New Opportunities</u>

Covid restrictions, tight controls by police, has "forced" our pastors, interns and believers to do what we have dreamed about and taught for many years...

Equipping and releasing the believers in our church to start small groups of one-on-one disciple-making. The "professional clergy" model is a strong value in the traditional church and "top-down" leadership structure of Myanmar culture.

But our local Myanmar Pastor has made it clear that making disciples is not a one person-"Sunday only" kind of job. Paul the Apostle said it well himself when he said, "Christ gave these gifts to prepare God's holy people for the work of serving, to make the body of Christ stronger." Eph.4:12

After many weeks of encouragement and training, our team of young people are doing it! They have are started at least 6 new discipleship groups.

One young women on our team told me, "Sayama, I told the woman I am discipling (who is the only believer in her village.) that God is going to use her to lead her community to Jesus and that we will have a house church here. She was so happy! She asked me to come and teach her every week!"




For Further Reflection
