

# MISSION UPDATE: Isra & Sandra Chavez Plett (Multiply)

A couple of weeks ago Isra and I had the privilege of overseeing our HADIME students as we planned and prepared an experiential missions event for our local churches, with a call to stop the silence.

Did you know that in Mexico there is a zone, made up of 6 different States in Central Mexico, called the "Circle of Silence"? The state of Jalisco, where we are living, is part of the Circle. I could give you all kinds of facts and historical explanations, but let me just share that this region contains 75% of all the population of Mexico, and there are less than 1% of evangelical Christians living here.

We want the church in Mexico to be stirred up to understand the call to share the Gospel with those who haven't heard and understood, and we don't have to go very far!!!

Our students did a fantastic job of creatively setting up different stations, presenting different needs in Mexico, and practical ways the church can be involved. We had over 100 people come out and attend, and many were impacted to get out of their comfortable seats and start sharing.

Pray with us as we present the same program this weekend in our sister church in Ecatepec (Mexico City). And again on November 7th at a Guadalajara-wide Missions Festival. This time with a focus on youth.

In personal news we have been given the certificate of approval for adoption in the district of Zapopan! After all the paperwork, interviews and psychological exams we are thrilled to reach this milestone! This means we are currently on a waiting list for adoption in Zapopan. We recognize there are still lots of potential obstacles ahead. The pandemic has slowed things way down in government offices, and in this whole past year they only gave 1 child in adoption in Zapopan!

We have been encouraged to get out there and get ourselves on waiting lists in other districts. So this past week we did a little traveling to other areas. The situation is complicated, but we are now in process in at least one other district. We continue to sense God calling us forward in this process, and believe that God has blessed us to be able to provide love and family for someone who needs it, and pray for a miracle to happen. We invite you to be praying with us!
