

Notice from City of Winnipeg


- Starting the week of Jan 24th, we will begin a 7 week project to repair the sewer along the bank of Omand's Creek just south of Portage Ave.

MISSION UPDATE: Freedom House

Freedom House has continued to serve our community by providing takeout meals, winter clothing, personal hygiene products, and emergency food hampers. We are serving about 20 takeout breakfasts (per day) during the week and 180 takeout dinners on Sunday.

We are planning to continue the current method of ministry until the end of January and re-evaluate the situation based on Public Health Canada's orders. Please continue to pray for our community's well-being, our shelves be filled with non-perishable foods, and volunteer's safety.
