MISSION UPDATE - ICOMB

Tuning the instruments.

Musicians know that they need to adjust their instruments before the concert. Otherwise, they will miss their expected engagement and negatively affect the whole performance. And if they tune it while the show is going on, they will cause all others to stop playing or create a cacophony.

ICOMB is planning an important "concert" in May, called Despertar 22, preceded by an ICOMB Assembly. This will be the ICOMB Summit '22.

All participants are part of the concert; all play a smaller or bigger instrument, not only the organizers and stage people (speakers, moderators, worship team, etc.) Some will travel to Brasil; some will participate online. We all need to prepare for that event.

We still have ten weeks to do so. We will be sending out a reflection and a reminder every week that can help us prepare. And we will call this Tuning for Despertar '22

How can we prepare?

Worshiping: Intentionally worshiping God, who is greater, more loving, merciful, powerful than all of us.

Listening: Exposing myself to God. Come before God, not just to look for answers to my questions, but to hear what he thinks I need to hear, see, and answer.

Responding: Confess, receive his grace, agree with his truth and take the necessary steps.

LOOKING FORWARD

Our discipleship training course is heading to Nipawin, Saskatchewan for training and outreach this entire week. They will be taking classes and helping minister to local churches and First Nations reserves. Please be in prayer for this team as they practice evangelism and discipleship, for we battle not against flesh and blood. - Thursday: intercessory prayer for Nipawin, volunteering at Emmanuel Baptist Church to do whatever is needed most, sharing DTC with college students in the evening (Alex sharing testimony)
- Friday: intercessory prayer for Nipawin, leading youth night at Nipawin Holiness Church (Jaden, Jeramy & Leah sharing testimonies, Jaden & Jeramy leading the activities)
- Saturday: driving home
