LOOKING FORWARD

As a nonprofit organization it is very important for us to be legally operating in the same manner as we describe within our constitution. We've been using a constitution that was written in 2002, and much has changed since then, including our transition into a multi-ethnic church. So this year we decided to form a constitution committee, to create a proposed update for our constitution, in order to reflect who we are as a church today, and how we are operating.

This committee has been hard at work, and has drafted a proposed new constitution. We want to give the whole church a chance to read this proposed constitution and an explanation document that carefully explains the changes that have been made to the old constitution. We will then discuss these changes together in a townhall style meeting. This meeting will take place on Sunday, April 24, after the worship service. We will then meet again the following week, Sunday, May 1, to formally vote on the proposed constitution. We invite you to both of these meetings as we prayerfully look to the future and take this important step together.
