Dear Friends.

In a call with all delegates on March 24th, we mentioned two Bible verses before hearing about the situation in Ukraine.

This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; he is my God, and I trust him. Psalms 91:2 NLT

And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.' Mat 25: 40

These two verses are two sides that need to go together. One side is, we need to realize, there are moments in our life where we will find refuge, safety, peace only in communion with God. There are no men or women to change our situation, and we will have to learn for ourselves and encourage others to see this reality.

The other side is that even the slightest help I give to a person in need, I'm giving it to Jesus, I'm serving Jesus, and the receiver can accept it as from Jesus. Offering help can be an answer to a prayer.

Seeking God, depending on him, and serving each other always go hand in hand.
