MISSION UPDATE - Dave & Louise Sinclair-Peters

We had just sent our team of pastors in Myanmar a little bus money so they could travel from village to village teaching at our local summer discipleship schools when we received a panicked phone call; "Teacher, we need you to pray! Pastor Zinko, Pastor Than Naing, Pastor Maung Myint, his son and Pastor Maung Kan were all arrested last night!"

Pastor Zinko had traveled from Yangon to Mindone with Pastor Moe Aung's daughter earlier that evening. Excited to meet old friends, Pastor Than Naing came down the mountain to welcome our team and to make plans for the discipleship school. At about 11pm, the police with their guns drawn, kicked open the door of Maung Myint's house and ordered all the men to get down on the floor. The police then put them in hand-cuffs and took them away.

When the believers heard what happened to their pastors, they sent messages asking for prayer throughout Thailand and Myanmar. Then one of the pastor's wives sent us a message; "Teacher, please delete all the names of the pastors that are in jail from your group pages on social media! The soldiers have taken their phones and are now checking their text messages to see if they are involved in the civil disobedience movement." None of our pastors were involved but Adrienne quickly deleted their names just in case!

After the second night, still without any news from our team, Zinko's wife called us in tears. We didn't need to ask her what she was worried about. We all knew too well what she was thinking. We knew exactly what the brutal Myanmar Military was capable of doing to people they suspected of fighting against the government.

Interrogation, intimidation, torture, death. Those are the rules they live by.
