Starting this coming week the weekly prayer ministry time will be Wednesdays at 2:30pm. We welcome everybody to join us!


Cooking Class Ministry - May 14th @ 10am

Congregational Meeting - the minutes of last week's meeting are available on the foyer table and online on Church Connect
















MISSION UPDATE - Emily Reeve

MISSION UPDATE - Simonhouse Bible Camp
On April 14, the Board of Directors met to talk about the upcoming
summer and had to make the regrettable decision to cancel the
camp programs for 2022.

While COVID restrictions now allow us to run, the prior restrictions in place prevented us being able to do the usual staff recruitment trips and functions and we do not have nearly enough potential staff who have shown interest this summer. In addition to that, we sustained some significant damage around camp and require a lot of work to be done to run the best programs we can. So this year we are focusing on getting the site back and ready, and will work hard at our staff recruitment for next year already. We are looking at a few things we may be able to do including a Work & Discipleship week or two for staff to stay engaged, as well has having various churches send work groups up to help get the site ready for camp. We have a few committed in and potentially could use a few more if you have a group interested.

These years have not been going the way we would like them to, but we are trusting that the Lord is working even in the midst of uncertainty. We trust Him as we work on these projects this year and plan for 2023 already. Thanks for your prayers with and for us!



We are looking forward to all the ministries starting up as we come out of a long season of on-and-off lockdowns. We are starting up our Winnipeg Walks ministry, Cooking Class ministry, our games night, a new movie night, and our summer church picnics.
