MISSION UPDATE – Matt Peters @ Equip Canada "Can you believe that spring is FINALLY here in Manitoba?! Well at least the weather is warm, sunny and "spring-like", although our fields and highways are under spring melt flood water and the backcountry rivers are raging and the lakes are still frozen over. Things are looking up, but it seems like there is still some waiting yet to happen...

This has been a long and weary winter for many of us. Personally the weather we've experienced has been a reflection of how I have been emotionally and mentally feeling throughout the season. Although my health has continued to slowly improve, I still have days of doubt, frustration, and grief. More tests and doctor appointments have revealed that it's unknown as to its cause and even how to treat it. My only option at this point is to press on as best I can with life and deal with it. In many regards it's encouraging, yet some days it still throws me off as I have vivid nightmares of that horrible day last spring and the months following it. That all to say that it's been a long, dark, and cold season of trying to figure things out.

On the brighter side, this spring I feel more breath in my lungs and more jump in my step then I have at any other point this past year. With so much of our planning constantly changing month by month throughout the pandemic, it's been a challenge to offer consistent outdoor programs. As it stands, Manitoba has now dropped restrictions and most of the organizations I've been helping and supporting the past 2 years have gone back to their own camps and programs they've been operating before the pandemic. This is great news and I'm excited for the hard work our community has done to keep these vital programs alive. Moving forward there is a sense of normalcy and ability to plan 2-4 months ahead. It's refreshing!




