## MISSION UPDATE - Israel & Sandra Chavez Plett

### "That's Not My Name...Call Me Son"

That was Sebastian's response almost 4 weeks ago when we told him we want to be his mommy and daddy. He no longer wants us to call him Sebastian, but thrills at having someone finally call him "son". It's been quite a journey, but let me catch you up. Sebastian has lived all of his 5 years, except the first two months, in an orphanage just 2 blocks from our house. He has been well loved and cared for by an amazing staff of people, where he was told his "tummy mommy" wasn't able to take care of him, and they were going to look after him until his "heart mommy and daddy" would find him.

Although adoption has long been on our hearts, Isra and I started taking practical steps about a year ago. It's been a year of taking adoption preparation courses, mounds of paperwork, medical tests and getting certified. And then we had to go to each municipal office to get our names on waiting lists. In December we began the same process over again, but now to get certified as foster parents. By mid-March we were certified, and the DIF (Mexican Child and Family Services) presented us with options to foster. The next day a new file came across their desk and they let us know about Sebastian. Sebastian's case was different, because instead of fostering he had just been liberated for adoption.
