

MISSION UPDATE - Central Multiply Canada

For over twenty years I have been calling, equipping, and sending young adults to be on mission among our global family of missionaries. Recently at the International Community of MB Churches (ICOMB) summit in Curitiba Brazil, Jose Prada, our Colombian mission partner shared a word of encouragement.

"Carol, when you sent ACTION teams to us, they emboldened our Colombian young adults to go into the community and translate their testimonies, and share the Gospel of Jesus. Our Colombian youth were encouraged by the Canadian youth and vise-versa. Today we have new church plants in the communities where they ministered together. There are more communities that need reaching, can you send us teams of young adults again?"

Encouragement goes both ways! The Canadian youth went to Colombia with a prepared testimony and eagerness to serve. The Colombians were encouraged to share boldly in their home community because they were hosting the Canadians. Together, these young people exercised faith in Jesus and the seeds of the Gospel were planted, watered, and bore a harvest.

Can we imagine inviting youth from other nations, languages, and cultures to join us on mission in our city or community... to encourage this generation of disciple-makers and church planters?


