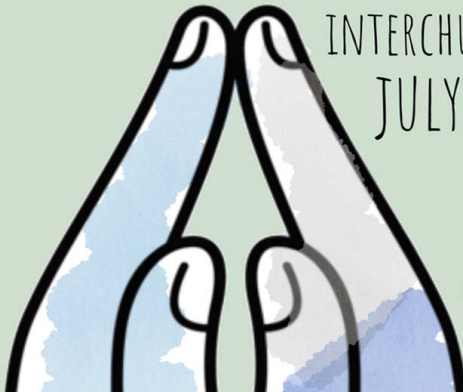
LOOKING FORWARD
