Aneta Dyck has moved to Donwood Manor Personal Care Home. Her new adress will be available in Church Connect shortly.




# MISSION UPDATE - Vision For Mission: Sinclair-Peters

In May, we had the joy of taking a group of Thai pastors to their first summit of the International Community of Mennonite Brethren (ICOMB) in Curitiba, Brazil. It was very encouraging for our team to be with other leaders who also come from nations that experience persecution and opposition for following Jesus Christ. There were twenty-three nations represented.

One day, a Brazilian pastor took our Thai pastors to meet Abdullah. As we sat in the restaurant drinking coffee, Abdullah told us that he was born in Lebanon to a devout Muslim family and was sent to a school to become a Jihadist. "By the time I was a teenager," Abdullah said, "I was convinced that if I became a suicide bomber, I would receive an eternal reward. So men attached bombs to my body and sent me into a Jewish neighborhood."

He shouted in Arabic, "God is great!" and pressed the button, but the bomb would not detonate. He tried again and again, but nothing happened. Later, he found out that his Jihadist teachers were videotaping the entire event and knew the bombs were fake. "They used the video as a recruiting tool," Abdullah said, "and I became a hero in my community."
