## MISSION UPDATE – Multiply: Dave & Louise Sinclair-Peters

This week I was saddened to learn that three young soldiers that we had helped to shelter here in Mae Sot had been killed fighting against the Myanmar military last month. Only one man in the group that we shared the Gospel with stayed back and was baptized. This is why whenever Pastor Janu gets an invitation to go and share the love of Jesus Christ with the soldiers, no matter how dangerous it is, she has to go!

Last week Pastor Janu and her daughter Shalom were invited to go deep into the jungle in Myanmar and share the Good News with 300 soldiers. For a whole day, the soldiers listened to the teachings of Jesus. All the soldiers responded to the free gift of eternal life bought for them by Christ's death on the cross. Repenting for their sins, they asked Jesus to fill them with faith and the Holy Spirit.

A few days later, Pastor Janu received a call from one of the soldiers. "Sayama, when can you come back?" He asked. "I already have a list of 80 soldiers who want to be baptized!"

Next week Pastor Janu and two other pastors will travel back to the army camp for 3 days of discipleship training.

# WHAT'S HAPPENING

## **From the Refugee Committee**

We have received \$3,875 in donations over the last few weeks - thanks to everybody for your generosity. We have also received very generous donations of furniture recently - with what is currently in the Choir Room, and what has been promised, we now have more than enough to furnish an apartment. For the time being, please don't offer any more furniture.

What we need more than anything else at the moment is your time and effort:

The current Refugee Committee is getting old, and we need more energetic people to serve on the Committee. Tasks can include shifting furniture, helping to navigate Canadian immigration bureaucracy, and walking with recently arrived refugees as they adjust to Canadian life. We are particularly keen to recruit women for this - because of cultural issues, some refugee women will find it awkward to be helped by a man.

We do a lot of furniture moving, and this always needs a pickup truck or a van. At the moment, this work devolves on one or two individuals. We would like to build up a list of people who have access to suitable vehicles, and would be willing to help on an occasional basis.
