Well, be prepared to be surprised- but all the author's conclusions are backed up by detailed scriptural references. This book was of immense help to me, giving me much comfort. After twenty-five years of intensely studying the Bible, both Old and New Testament, the author has described Heaven the way Scripture does - "a bright vibrant and physical new earth, free from sin, death, and brimming with Christ's presence, wondrous natural beauty, and the richness of human culture as God intended it to be." This is a book about real people with real bodies enjoying close relationships with God and each other. It is a long book but is also great for just dipping into areas that you might have questions about.
