MISSION UPDATE Greg Wiens - Multiply

Greg is our speaker for this morning so this is an opportunity to learn more about the mission work he is doing.

Greg grew up on a grain farm in Southern Manitoba near the village of Domain. He has served as a pastor in the Mennonite Brethren Church Conference since 1999. Greg attended Columbia Bible College and Providence University in Manitoba. He met his wife Heather at Columbia Bible College and they married in 1998. Heather teaches English to immigrants and refugees. Greg and Heather have three children, twins Hannah and Aaron (2000) and Bethany (2005).

Greg wears a few different hats, all of them ministry-focused. He is the lead pastor of Westwood Community Church. Greg also works part time as a Mission Mobilizer with Multiply, and as the Faith Based Coordinator of Global Vision 20/20. Global Vision 20/20 is an award winning innovation that gets new eyeglasses on the faces of the poorest 2.5 billion people who have no access to optometrists. It enables people in developing countries to self diagnose thier prescription for eyeglasses. With three hours of training this award winning system is able to give out prescription eyeglasses for under \$5.

Greg's job is to get this incredible tool into the hands of faith communities so that they can use it to help the poor and oppressed.

Recently this work has started getting considerable worldwide attention on social media, with over a million video views on TikTok. He has been invited to appear on the Kelly Clarkson show in the fall. Be in prayer for Greg as he works to bring attention to this important work for the poor, and simultaneously seeks to shine the light of Christ into areas that need to receive God's love.

Book Review

In his memoir, Where the Light Fell author Philip Yancey delves into the circumstances of his life which contributed to making him the person he has become. He grew up in the deep south of America in a church situation which was racist and narrowly fundamental. His father died of polio when he was just an infant leaving his mother struggling with poverty and raising two small boys alone. Two women especially impacted his life. One was his mother, an angry, harsh person at home while being a model Christian in public. The other woman was Janet whom he met in college and eventually married. Janet helped him heal from the childhood trauma and helped him in understanding a God of love. Philip Yancey is the author of 25 Christian books, many of which are available in the church library.


