Housing for Afghan Christian Refugees - We are expecting two Afghan Christian refugee families to arrive before Christmas. Unfortunately, we won't know the exact date of their arrival until shortly before they arrive. One family consists of a husband and wife with no children, and they will need a one-bedroom apartment. The other family is a couple with four children, and they will need a three-bedroom house or apartment. We would like to find accommodation that is centrally located, near a bus route, and with moderate rent. So we are asking all members who live in rented accommodation: does your landlord have any houses or apartments to rent which might be suitable? If so, please get in touch with Norman Cameron.

# MISSION UPDATE Vision for Mission - Multiply

It was the worst way to start summer camp. Within minutes after campers had arrived, one of them was being pulled out of the lake and the lifeguard was desperately trying to revive him.

One of our global workers was a leader at the camp, and she gave us this firsthand account: "I was in the main office building when, all of a sudden, a lifeguard rushed past me and grabbed the defibrillator and started running back to the lake. I followed her outside and caught sight of the horrific scene on the dock—a group of lifeguards doing CPR on a camper. I started to feel sick. We sent all of the campers and leaders to their cabins while we waited for the ambulance to arrive. As the lifequards continued doing CPR, I stepped up beside the mom of one of our leaders who used to be a nurse on a cardiac unit. She was looking at her watch and counting the minutes. We started crying out to Jesus to save this boy's life. Behind us, one of the leaders had gathered the campers at the cabins and was leading them in prayer. We were all asking God for one thing—a miracle. Because the CPR was continuing on and on, the nurse fell to her knees in the grass and started crying out to God. Then, suddenly, they stopped the CPR. The boy was breathing!"
