Housing for Afghan Christian Refugees

We are expecting two Christian refugee families to arrive before Christmas. One will need one-bedroom place, the other will need a three-bedroom. We would like to find accommodation that is centrally located, near a bus route, and with moderate rent. If you know of any houses or apartments to rent which might be suitable, please contact Norman Cameron.

We have a food bin in the foyer where we invite you to drop off canned food and other non-perishable food. We anticipate using these items first for any refugees we come into contact with via our various ministries.

DRY BEAN DRIVE

Many people in Manitoba are having difficulty putting enough food on the table. Harvest Manitoba had its busiest year ever in 2021, with 80,000 Manitobans needing its services each month. Inflation and other factors have driven that up even higher this year, to almost 90,000 Manitobans monthly. Sadly, almost half of them are children.

Our annual Dry Bean Drive is a fantastic way to help these struggling people. We research the best food item to donate so that we can help as many people as possible, by providing the most nutritious food at the lowest cost. For years now we have chosen dry beans or dry peas... this year the winner is whole yellow peas. These get used for soups in soup kitchens across the province.

We urge our church to donate to this important cause, above and beyond our regular church budget giving. You can donate:

- 1) via e-transfer to payments@pachurch.ca (write "Dry Bean Drive" in the memo)
- 2) with credit card at pachurch.ca/connect (select the "Dry Bean Drive" drop-down option)
- 3) with cash/check (write "Dry Bean Drive" on a donation envelope)

The drive will run from December 11 to January 8. If you are wanting a 2022 tax receipt, make sure to donate by Saturday, Dec 31. Most of us, without even thinking about it, expect to eat every day of the year, and in fact, several times every day! Let's help those around us who are not as fortunate as we are.
