Library News - parents, there are lots of Christmas books on the table in the foyer for you to sign-out for your children, so come and have a look! And there are some items for adults as well.

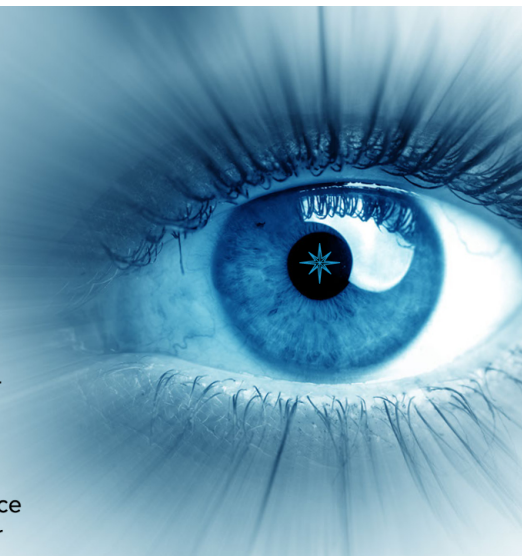
Dry Food Bin Donations - remember to drop off canned food and other non-perishable food for refugees in the box in the foyer.

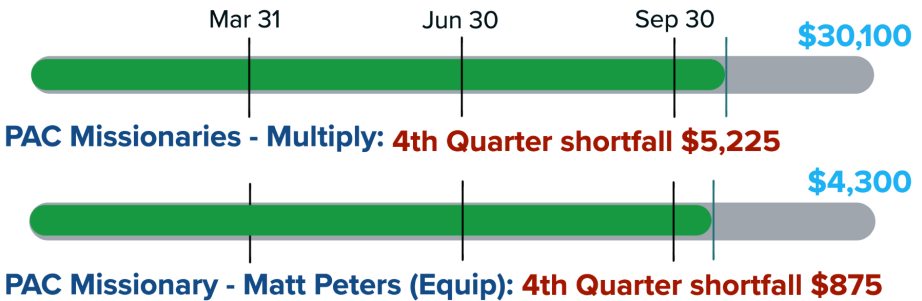

NB: Quarterly support payments are sent only once pledge has been met.

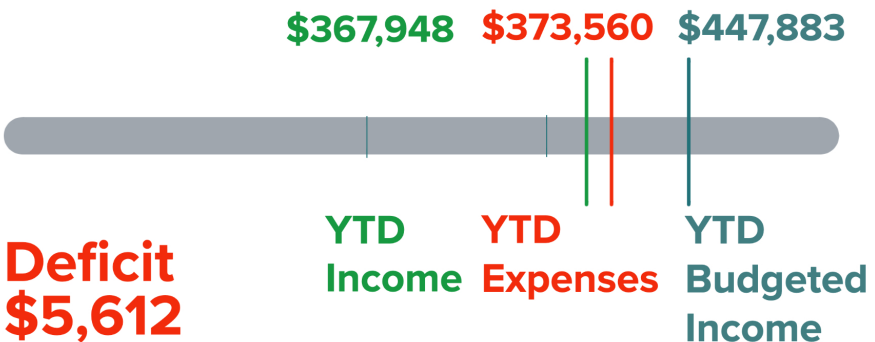
