
Knit & Knead - the next Knit & Knead (Women's Fellowship) is Saturday, March 18, at 10am

Refugee Ministry Update – March 2023

As you will hear today, the Anwari family, sponsored by our church, arrived in Winnipeg just before Christmas. Now he has an excellent job, his children are in school and doing well, and he told us a few days ago that from March 1st he won't need any more financial support from PAC.

Now we are expecting two more families. Since they will still be in danger until they step on the plane going to Canada, we won't use their real names. The next family we are expecting to come is a couple, husband and wife, Adam and Eve. Then there is another family coming: the father, who we will call Benjamin, together with his wife and three children. Both families are Afghan Christians.

Now we need donations to support both families when they arrive we have an obligation to support them for a full year, if they don't become self-supporting before the year is out. As you know, we have a Refugee Fund. We will be setting up a separate account for each family to track all financial activities.

Adam and Eve will require a total of \$21,800 to support them for a full year. Benjamin and his family will require rather more than this. Our immediate target is to raise \$21,800, so that we can be confident of supporting the family without dipping into the legacy funds (we can only spend these funds once!). Portage Avenue Church has an enviable record of meeting our refugees' needs without dipping into reserves, and we hope we can keep this up. So we are appealing for donations from the congregation.

Please designate your donations for the Refugee Fund. All donations will be receipted.

We will give you a regular update until we meet the required sum. Currently, we are only asking for money. Later we will ask for practical help and specific household items.

The Lord has blessed this ministry and we pray that we remain faithful.
