**April Communion** - We will not have communion on Palm Sunday, but we will celebrate together on Good Friday.






Easter is coming quickly! For those who are new to PAC, here is a bit of a run down of what to expect. :-) Next week, Apr 2nd, is Palm Sunday. Traditionally, churches have palm branches available for people to wave during worship - we usually encourage the kids to participate in this. It is traditionally a celebration service.

The following Friday, Apr 7th, is Good Friday. Traditionally here at PAC this is a funeral type service meaning people typically dress in funeral attire and it is a solemn service. Please note there is no children programming for this service and children are expected to remain with their parents for the whole service. It is a time for reflection and we will celebrate communion together.

The Sunday following (Apr 9th) is Easter Sunday. We are celebrating with 4 baptisms that day! We will also have something special for the Kids in the Word time and following the service everyone is invited to Fellowship Cafe to enjoy some homemade Paska (Mennonite Easter Bread.) 
