


CHAPTER-A-DAY BIBLE READING PLAN

MISSIONS UPDATE - Multiply

Thank you for your generosity in empowering single mothers in Uganda to start their own businesses and become economically active in their communities. The Lifehouse Community Church and King's Kid Ministries, run by Robert Mponye, are deeply grateful for your support towards this project. Your gift has enabled many destitute single women to fend for themselves and provide for their families through the resourcing and vocational training they have received.

King's Kid Ministry is driven by the passion to empower women to become the people God has called them to be, with a focus on the reconciliation of the entire family. The resourcing has three main objectives: to enable single mothers to become economically independent; to disciple single mothers to become faithful stewards of God's resources; and to create a sense of community among the single mothers as they support one another through the profits they have generated from their businesses.

Robert Mponye reports that over this past year thirty two single mothers have been funded, and that the vocational training is ongoing as women are equipped to run businesses ranging from raising chickens and pigs to retail, hairdressing and running a children's daycare center. Robert relays: "This has given many of them their God-given dignity back! A poverty cycle is being broken!"

The benefits of women's economic empowerment for society and families is well established and has shown to lead to increased investments in children's education and well-being. To this end King's Kid School has been able to feed, dress, educate and most importantly give spiritual nurturing to over 350 children this year!

In 2022 the academic performance of students at King's Kid School was a testament to God's goodness with five first graders, twelve second graders and two third graders graduating.

Further to this the ground floor of King's Kid Vocational Training Center has been completed. This facility will allow for over thirty students to receive vocational training to help them live a life with purpose.
