

CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATE

Pass-through Donations to Charities

You can currently make a donation to a charity by using Portage Avenue Church as an intermediary – that is to say, you make the donation to PAC and instruct PAC to pass the donation on to your favourite charity. PAC passes the donation on and gives you a receipt.

The next congregational meeting will be held on Sunday April 30th. The main business of the meeting will be approval of the 2022 financial statements. However, Church Council will also be proposing a motion to end the practice of pass-through donations.

The reason for this is the burden this practice places on our hard-pressed administrative staff. Currently, about 40% of all the payments made through the RBC Pay Edge system are pass-through payments.

So we propose that from December 31st, 2023, PAC will no longer process pass-through payments. Of course, this change will only happen if members vote in favour of it. This change will not affect donations to charities that PAC supports directly, such as Square One World Media, Simonhouse Bible Camp, ICOMB, MBBS, YFC (Emily Cook), and Multiply. This change will also not affect donations to our various projects such as PAC Missionaries, Refugee Fund etc.

We recognize that members wish to support many worthy charities, and we don't want this support to be reduced. We recommend that members send their support directly to the charity of their choice. Members of PAC staff will be happy to give advice on how this can be done.
