Let's be in prayer for our immigrants (and our local business owners and employers) that God might help us bring the right people together to help these immigrants.





# MISSION UPDATE - Jen Schmidt

It's become more and more life giving for me in these last years to accompany and disciple the different young adults that God brings into my path. This last week I took the two young women that I've been journeying with in these months, and a former student from the 2019 Hadime program for coffee. It was some special moments of celebration and sharing. These months haven't been without their challenges in discipleship and walking with these women, but I'm grateful for these opportunities to journey with them. In these months, I've seen and felt God stirring in my heart and feel like I'm learning more and more how to walk faithfully with women like Danna and Yamileth. Both of these young women I begun to meet with and pray for in the summer of 2021, for that reason it's been special to continue to meet and pray with them, and feel like it's such a privilege for me to see how God is at work in each of their lives.

Camila joined us on a coffee date last week because she is transitioning into mentoring and walking with them in these next months. Just about a year ago, I was sensing an invitation from the Lord to take some sabbatical time. And while I was considering this, I also really felt that God put in my heart the need for us as a team to continue investing in leaders. Camila and Lucho were dating students in the 2019 program. They were married in 2021 and have a heart for young adults and seeing God's kingdom strengthened and expanded throughout the nations. As I shared some ideas regarding a sabbatical and the idea of inviting this couple to join us for 6 months (in part to also help cover some of my responsibilities), my team was open and affirming of these ideas. So Camila will continue on in discipleship as I venture out this week on 3 months of sabbatical time. I have great confidence and trust in how God will use Camila in the lives of these women!
