
We are celebrating and honouring our graduates this Sunday!



Here are two reviews for books that were highly recommended to all the women in the women's Bible Study group that met this past year and really should be a must read for all of us at PAC.

Fifty-seven words that change the world : a journey through the Lord's prayer / by Darrell Johnson

Nowhere is Jesus' brilliance more manifest than in the prayer he taught his disciples to pray, the prayer that has come to be known as the 'Lord's Prayer.' A mere fifty-seven words in the original Greek, the Lord's Prayer gathers up all of life and brings it before God. The Beatitudes / by Darrell Johnson

The Beatitudes found in Matthew 5:1-12 have often been experienced as either frustrating idealism or oppressive legalism. This book will show that they are neither. They are the result of Jesus and His gospel getting a hold on us! Readers of the book will find freedom and encouragement as they understand that in these famous words Jesus is simply describing what He is doing in the people that He calls to Himself. The eight 'blessed are' Jesus speaks from a Galilean mountain are probably the most well-known of all His sayings. Rightly understood, they turn the world up-side down! The good news of Jesus is that the long-awaited kingdom of God is breaking into the world - God is breaking into our brokenness to heal and restore.
