# MISSION UPDATE - Chavez-Plett Family

Back in December Perla began attending our literacy classes at Punto Vida (LifePoint) because she isn't able to go to school right now, but wants so badly to keep learning. As Perla came each day, we began to chat with her mom Itzel and learn more about their story. They are from the state of Michoacan, but when Itzel reached 7 months of her pregnancy with twins they realized that she was at high risk, and would need a good hospital for her and the babies. So, as a family they packed up a few things and came to Guadalajara where they would receive better medical care. The babies were born via emergency C-section at 7 months, with many health problems. So the family has had to stay put where the babies could receive extra care. They managed to rent a house in the Punto Vida neighborhood, where they live with 1 mattress they all share on the floor, and a borrowed fridge and stove that some kind neighbors lent them. Itzel's husband works nights to support the family. Itzel, who was abandoned by her own mother as a young child, is determined to be more present in the lives of her own kids. We were able to hire Itzel a couple of days a week to help around the thrift store, fold and pack diapers, and accompany Emilia. It's not much financially, but we have enjoyed "being family" for her and her kids, holding the babies, helping feed them, playing with Perla, and picking her up for Sunday school and craft classes when Itzel isn't able to bring her. Itzel's husband recently mentioned to her his interest in getting to know this church who has become family to his wife and kids, and so we are hopeful that he will visit us soon. Pray with us for them as a family, and what God is wanting to do in each of their hearts.

The Chavez-Plett family will be in Canada this fall for a couple months visiting our churches. We hope to see most of you while we are up there! Once we have our dates figured out we will send out the information of where and when we will be in your area. We can't wait for you to meet our son in person, and to share in more details what God is doing through the ministry we are a part of. See you soon!!!
