

Farewells in Punto Vida (LifePoint Ministry)

Our ministry is marked by certain seasons, and one of those is the coming and going of our volunteers. We have currently been in a season of farewells as we wrapped up our HADIME Raices program, as well as said farewell to our MCC volunteer.

After 6 months of teaching, training and walking alongside our 10 participants, we had a little grad ceremony and commissioned them to return to their home contexts. Continue to pray for them as they take what they have learned and walk out the specific call God has for each one of them. We continue to be impacted by the challenges facing this generation, and are reminded that it is a daily decision to press in and follow Jesus!

For 3 weeks we led this intensive discipleship program this summer. Here are a few of the details:

- 6 participants from different parts of Mexico seeking to go deeper with God
- 3 past students who served as volunteers
- 3 past students, and personal disciples of ours, who came on as leaders for this program
- 2 participants who couldn't commit to the whole summer, but joined us the first week because they wanted more of Jesus
- 10 SOAR participants from Kansas, USA who joined us for a week of outreach in Mexico State
- 4 days of survival camp learning valuable lessons about First Aid, team building, and the importance of Spiritual first aid.
- 1 week of classes, personal discipleships, and learning together at MTC
- 10 days of outreach in Mexico State
- 3 different churches where we did evangelism and ran kids programs
