Men's Breakfast - October 28 at 10am



MISSION UPDATE - Jen Schmidt

Many of you may remember Jocelyn who was with me in Canada last fall when I was visiting churches. Jocelyn was in our Hadime program in 2021 and last fall she was learning English, with the goal of heading to Thailand now this fall to participate in a missions mobilization program. I returned to GDL in August just in time to give her a hug, pray with her and send her off to Thailand for the next 8 months! Praise God for His provision in her paperwork (visas, etc) and for finances for her flights. We are hoping to cover another 400\$ USD for her costs over the next 7 months, so there is still time to partner with her and us in this sending of Jocelyn for further training. In conversation with her, she is doing well, 1 month in, experiencing new cultures all around her (her teammates are 2 young women from Africa), and learning much around the themes of mobilization and mission. Jocelyn has said to me on numerous occasions since arriving to Thailand, that spending 4 months in Canada was so helpful for her now as she crosses greater cultural divides as it helped train and prepare for this experience.

Fall 2023 is underway and it's meant that I'm the only part of the MTC team living onsite for these next number of months. We have had former students Camila and Lucho from Colombia serving with us as volunteers for the last 5 1/2 months. They leave in 2 weeks time and will leave a big gap at MTC. I've also had former students and brothers from GDL onsite helping with some upkeep and maintenance. It's always a special time to be able to share meals together, reminisce and be challenged by one another in our walks with the Lord.

Pray for our Hadime 2024 program as we prepare and plan for students who will arrive in January 2024. Pray that God would send the right group of students and for wisdom for us as leaders as we prepare for that time of training.
