


BOOK REVIEW & LIBRARY NEWS

Liking Jesus: intimacy and contentment in a selfie-centered world - by Craig Groeschel

Set down your selfie stick and pick up this book instead! Having phones and computers at our fingertips can be amazing, but it also causes plenty of struggles in our lives. You won't hear the author tell us to discard the techie toys you've grown to love, but you will be challenged to put your device in its rightful place. Through story telling, lots of humour and biblical truths, this is a compelling and thought-provoking book.
