We will also have a gift exchange - if you are able, please wrap up a gently used item from your own household that you no longer use and would be a blessing for someone else.






We're looking forward to Christmas!

PAC BEAN DRIVE

For years now, many people in Manitoba have been having difficulty putting enough food on their tables. Unless you don't use the internet, and don't watch television, you are likely aware of this. And if you buy groceries, you know this to be true.

To help these struggling people, we are once again holding our annual Dry Bean Drive. Since adding dry beans or dry peas to the human diet is an excellent way of providing protein, we identify the most cost-effective variety of beans or peas available each year, purchase them **in bulk**, and donate them to Harvest Manitoba. Harvest Manitoba, in turn, re-distributes them to food banks and soup kitchens across the province. This year, we will once again be purchasing **whole yellow dry peas.**

We urge you to donate to this important cause, above and beyond your regular church budget giving.

You can donate:

- 1) via e-transfer to payments@pachurch.ca (write "2023 Dry Bean Drive" in the memo);
- 2) via credit card at pachurch.ca/connect (select the "Dry Bean Drive" drop-down option); or
- 3) via cash/cheque (write "2023 Dry Bean Drive" on your donation envelope). Please put your donation envelope in the offering plate.

Today, December 17th, is the third Sunday of our Drive, which will run until December 24th, 2023. If you require a 2023 tax receipt for your donation, be sure to donate by Sunday, December 31st, 2023.

Most of us take for granted that we will eat every day; in fact, likely several times a day! Let's help those around us who are not as fortunate as we are.
