New books for children and youth have arrived in the library.

For kids ages 6-10:

The Dead Sea Squirrel Series / Mike Nawrocki (creator of VeggieTales)

The library has added three new title to this series. The Dead Sea Squirrels tells the story of Merle and Pearl, two 1st century squirrels from Israel who've been preserved in sea salt in a cave alongside the Dead Sea, where 10-year-old Michael discovers them 2000 years later and sneaks them back home in his backpack. The silly adventures of this couple and their new friend are full of action, humour, and character-building lessons.

For 12-15 year olds:

Escape from the Everglades / Tim Shoemaker

After Parker Buckman is mauled and nearly killed by an alligator, he sees the Everglades as a place of death. Even though he's a park ranger's son, he's convinced he won't be truly okay until he can leave the glades. When his friend Maria goes missing, Parker knows he can't leave until he finds her-- or proof that she's dead. When his search brings him face-to-face with a rogue monster gator, will be find the strength to face his fears?

For ages 12-adult, a new graphic novel

The Chosen: Volume 1 - Called By Name

The Chosen: Volume 1 contains original graphic novel depictions from the television show, The Chosen, through the eyes of world-class artists.
