PAC BEAN DRIVE

Many people in Manitoba are having difficulty putting enough food on their tables. Even if you don't use the internet, or watch television, you are likely aware of this based on your own experience shopping for groceries.

Since adding dry beans or dry peas to the human diet is an excellent way of providing protein, our annual Dry Bean Drive is an effective way to help these struggling people. Each year, we identify the most cost-effective variety of beans or peas available, purchase them in bulk, and then donate them to Harvest Manitoba. Harvest Manitoba, in turn, re-distributes them to food banks and soup kitchens across the province. This year, we will once again be purchasing whole yellow dry peas.

We urge you to donate to this important cause, above and beyond your regular church budget giving. You can donate via:
